Oxekow er en fordanskning af "Oczakow", der er en ukrainsk by og fæstning ved Sortehavet. . . Dans og musik skal nok symbolisere den belejring af Oczakow, som russerne foretog i 1788 og som endte med, at de jog tyrkerne ud af fæstningen.

Melodien findes på Ærø allerede i 1800 og på Roskildeegnen havde den navnet "Oksekovs belejring".
